- 5) Presentation Abstract (Please submit a summary of your presentation in Microsoft Word or PDF format, including your awareness of the issues, the main points of your argument, your perspective, and your key findings, in no more than 1,200 characters on A4 paper.)
- 6) Language of presentation (Japanese or English)

Notification of Acceptance/Rejection

The Program Committee will review and select presentations and notify applicants by email in early April.

Online Pre-Conference Study Sessions for Unifying Themes

The Program Committee will conduct online pre-conference study sessions for the unifying themes by sub-theme from mid-May to mid-June. The Program Committee will coordinate the schedule for these study sessions and invite presenters, moderators, and discussants to the study sessions beginning in mid-April. At that time, the abstracts submitted by the presenters will be made available to the participants.

The purpose of the online Preliminary Study Sessions is to provide a meaningful forum for discussion as an academic society, combining the presentation and discussions of the

conference day. After confirming the purpose of the unifying theme, the participants should confirm the content of the presentations and discussions on the day of the conference, set the direction, and conduct preliminary questioning. As a reference, moderators are asked to use the following guidelines to manage the study sessions on the day of the conference.

- 1) Presenter 1: 20 minutes for presentation.
- 2) Moderator: 10 minutes for comments.
- 3) Presenter 2: 20 minutes for presentation.
- 4) Moderator: 10 minutes for comments.
- 5) Presenter 3: 20 minutes for presentation.
- 6) Moderator: 10 minutes for comments.
- 7) Discussant: 20 minutes for comments.
- 8) All attendees (including program committee members): 60 minutes for free discussion.

Deadline and method for submitting the final version of the presentation abstract (4-8 pages, A4 size)

Deadline: Sunday, July 20, 2025
